Town of Nespelem Ordinance 2021-07

An Ordinance Pertaining to the Obstruction of the Street, Sidewalk, Alley, Parking Strips or Other Town Properties

WHEREAS, Council for the Town of Nespelem approved Ordinance 99 adopted February 8, 1966, obstruction of streets; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Town of Nespelem has determined the need to limit the obstruction of the street, sidewalk, alley, parking strips or other town property that is owned or leased by the town over which the town has control thereof; and

NOW THEREFORE, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, group, or agents thereof to park or leave any, motorized vehicles, automobiles, trailers, or other vehicles, vehicles parts, and other unsightly debris whether or not the same is in a condition to be moved under its own power, upon the street, sidewalk, alley, parking strips or other town property for any period of time longer than seven (7) consecutive days; and

NOW THEREFORE, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, group, or agents thereof to park any motorized vehicles, automobiles, trailers, or other vehicles, within 20 feet of the nearest corner of any intersection of any street or alley in the town of Nespelem; and

NOW THEREFORE, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, group, or agents thereof to take apart any motorized vehicles, automobiles, trailers, other vehicles upon the street, sidewalk, alley, parking strips or other town property for the purpose of over-hauling or repairing for any period of time longer than seven (7) consecutive days; and

NOW THEREFORE, all ordinances and resolutions including but not limited to Ordinance 99 in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, any violation of this ordinance shall be an encroachment and will be disposed of or towed at the expense of owner. The impounding and storage of any forementioned shall be the sole and separate risk of the owner and without liability of any nature on the town of Nespelem or its agents; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the Town of Nespelem, Washington the attached ordinance is adopted. Approved this <u>10th</u> day <u>November</u> of <u>2021</u>.
